



Grant for a research stay of USP researchers at the University of Münster

The Brazil Center of the University of Münster (WWU) offers interested researchers one grant for research stay at the University of Münster. The exchange facility is part of the project **wwu.usp**, which aims to set a strategic partnership with the University of São Paulo (USP) in Brazil and is supported by DAAD.

Who can apply?

Lecturers and post-docs of any area (except some technical areas, such as engineering, veterinary, design)

What can be funded?

Short visit/research stay at the WWU

The grant serves the direct contact for the discussion of bilateral cooperation projects with existing or future partners at the WWU

Duration of the funding

Up to 1 month

Max. time span: until November 30th, 2018

Value

Monthly benefit of 2,000 Euros (under 22 days: 89 Euro/day) and travel allowance of 1,250 Euros, according to DAAD allowance rules

(No payments towards health, accident and personal liability insurance)

Documents needed for the application:

- - For Post-docs a letter of recommendation from the USP advisor. Post-docs must have a link to the USP
- Description of research focus and activities to be performed (use attached form)
- Commitment between the researchers/advisors (use sheet annexed to this call)

Selection

An independent selection committee consisting of specialist scientists reviews applications. The most important selection criterion is a convincing and well-planned visit/research stay.

Application

Interested researchers submit their applications via E-Mail as one single PDF-document to the Brazil Center of the WWU: brazil.center@uni-muenster.de

Application deadline: April 3rd, 2018

Incomplete submissions will not be considered!

Important remarks:

- The selection process takes place until May 18th, 2018
- The travel lump sum and the monthly/daily benefit will be paid after arriving in Münster.

Report:

After concluding the research stay the grant holders are requested to deliver a short report (ca. two pages, use report form annexed to this call), including performed activities, results and perspectives of further cooperation.


